<p>Civil Engineer officers are responsible for a broad range of engineering constructions; such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Determine requirements, establishes plans, provide designs and direct operations for maintenance, repair, alteration, addition and construction of facilities and utility systems -Develops, monitors and briefs survivability actions and methods to recover capabilities after attack -Maintains emergency response force to cope with enemy attacks, major accidents and natural disasters. -Maintains trained and equipped forces capable of responding to worldwide contingencies and military operations other than war. -Directs training, business practices and development activities - Provides on-scene advice to commander on control and integration of emergency response force. -Enforces standards of conduct, discipline, and adherence to laws and directives. -Coordinate activities with local, state, federal and host country agencies -Leads, manages, and directs CE personnel. -Plans, leads, and directs CE deployments. -Develops CE plans and policies -Determines personnel and material resource requirements. -Plans and establishes land use and provides environmental stewardship. -Acts as weapons recovery cell director as a member of the response task force for nuclear accidents.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -U.S. citizen. -Be a current member of the Alabama National Guard, or have the ability and willingness to join the Alabama ANG. -Hold a current passing Air Force Physical Fitness Assessment score. -Hold a Bachelor's degree or higher from an Accredited Institution as defined by the U.S. Office of Post-Secondary Education in Engineering. -Applicants who will complete their degree by May 2017 will be considered. -Have a passing AFOQT score, or the ability to take and pass the AFOQT. -Hold AFSC 32E3G, or have the ability to complete Air Force Civil Engineer Basic Course. -Hold, or have the ability to obtain a Secret security clearance.

Interested applicants who meet the eligibility criteria listed in this announcement may apply by submitting the below documents via email to the selecting official. Complete applications must be received no later than midnight on the closing date. Incomplete packages will not be considered for the position vacancy. Selecting officials have the right to hold package review boards prior to in-person interviews.

This position is a possible commissioning opportunity. Applicants seeking a commissioning must be able to complete the nine week accessions training as well as Completing Air Force Institute of Technology course WMGT 101 Air Force Civil Engineer Basic Course to earn the applicable AFSC 32E3G.
