# **COLONEL DOUGLAS D. DEMAIO**

Colonel Douglas D. DeMaio is the Commander of the 187th Fighter Wing. Dannelly Field, Alabama Air National Guard. He is responsible for 1,400 personnel, three geographically separated units, and 22 F-16 aircraft. He earned his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 1991, attended Euro-NATO Joint-Jet Pilot Training at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas, and has served in various roles as an F-16 Instructor Pilot and Flight Examiner at the squadron, group, and wing levels. Colonel DeMaio commanded the 55th Fighter Squadron at Shaw Air Force Base, South Carolina, deploying to Balad Air Base, Iraq, and later commanded the NATO Deployable Air Operations Center at Poggio Renatico, Italy. He is a graduate of the US Army's Command and General Staff College and School of Advanced Military Studies, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, and the Eisenhower School for National Security, Fort McNair, Washington D.C., earning Masters Degrees in Theater Operations and Long Term Strategy. As the Vice Commander of the LeMay Center for Doctrine, he served as a founding member of the Chief of Staff of the Air Force's Superiority, Multi-Domain Command and Control, Air and Electronic Warfare/Electromagnetic Spectrum Enterprise Capabilities Collaboration Teams. He coauthored the Department of the Air Force's Joint All-Domain Operations Doctrine, penned Counterspace Doctrine, and assisted the Space Force with doctrine and concepts. Colonel DeMaio is a Command Pilot with over 2,800 flight hours in the F-16 and a veteran of five combat deployments to Southwest Asia.
